This Month's Clinics Include

New Shooter and their Firearm

All too often, first time gun owners find themselves with no viable training opportunity, other than target practice on a public range. For some, that experience can be intimidating and often counter-productive. This clinic is designed to introduce beginner level shooters to proper range protocol, the safe operation of their personal firearm, and basic marksmanship. This is the next best thing to private, one-on-one instruction, for a fraction of the cost.

Objectives:

- Perform administrative loading and unloading procedures for selected firearm.
- Apply marksmanship fundamentals under live fire conditions.
- Conduct condition 1 and dry reloads.
- Disassemble, clean, inspect, re-assemble and function check select firearm.

Ladies Fundamentals of Shooting Clinic
